Amtrak achieved record revenue in November, reaching \$204.7 million in system-wide adjusted ticket revenue, the best month in the company's history.

### ERMA (GA-46000) 2018 Increased Lifetime Maximum

The lifetime maximum benefit under the Railroad Employees National Early Retirement Major Medical Benefit Plan (GA-46000) will increase by \$4,700 effective January 1, 2018 - from \$157,800 to \$162,500 - due to an automatic annual adjustment based on medical cost inflation.
